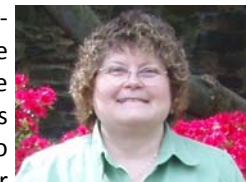

Keynote Speaker

Lois Hochstatter received her Bachelor's of Science degree in 1984 with a concentration in Psychology. She was the Assistant Director of a para-church ministry for four years counseling those who desired to leave the homosexual life-style. She graduated from Bethel Seminary with a Master's of Divinity Degree in 1996 with a concentration in Pastoral Care and Counseling. While going to school, she was the Assistant Director to Pastoral Care at Cedar Valley Assembly of God in Minnesota where she stayed for seven years. While working at the church, she did prayer ministry, helped facilitate Elijah House video schools, and oversaw 50 lay prayer ministers.



In 1998, she was asked to become part of the Elijah House team in Spokane, Washington in the training department overseeing video schools. In 2005, she became the Director of Training over live and video schools, nationally and internationally.

A little of what she says about her job: I love my job! I get to watch students "catch" how to pray for people as well as receive healing for themselves. It is fun to see the healing that Papa does in individuals who have the courage to share hurts in their small groups and are met with Papa's love. I also get to connect with facilitators who have the same type of experience I have in a live school. I get to encourage them as they encourage their students.

When I first moved from Minnesota, Papa asked me, "do you want to go on an adventure". I asked Him, "what does that mean?." Since I've been at Elijah House, the adventure has been to see Him work in people's lives for healing and wholeness and a deeper relationship with Him.
